ABOUT VINESIDE

Welcome to Vineside, your modern rustic retreat on a peaceful 2.2-acre property in Witchcliffe. This space is designed to be your home away from home, with a cosy king-sized bed, a well-equipped kitchen, and a spacious bathroom stocked with all-natural products.

Start your morning with a coffee on the private deck, or in the cooler months, head over to the seasonal firepit to unwind and enjoy views of the neighbouring vineyard.

We've thought of everything to make your stay as comfortable as possible, from the freshly baked bread and homemade jam to the eco-friendly touches throughout the house. The fully fenced yard offers plenty of privacy, and our friendly dogs, Lily and Luna, might drop by to say hello.

Whether you're here for a peaceful escape or to explore the beautiful Margaret River region, we hope you feel at home at Vineside. Take in the stunning surroundings, breathe in the fresh country air, and enjoy your stay in our little corner of paradise.

HOUSE GUIDE

We want your stay at Vineside to be as comfortable and relaxing as possible. Below is everything you need to know about making the most of your time here.

PARKING

Free parking is available for two cars. Go through the gate, follow the driveway and park on the white stones in front of the "Parking" sign. Please keep the driveway clear and the gate closed for our dogs' safety.

WATER CONSERVATION

Our water supply comes entirely from rainwater collected in our tanks, so it's essential to use it wisely. Last summer, we completely ran out of water, making conservation especially important.

Shower & Laundry Use: Please be mindful of your water usage when washing dishes and showering and only use the laundry if absolutely necessary.

Laundry Access: During the summer months, we can only offer laundry facilities to guests staying three nights or more.

Drinking Water: Our rainwater is clean, fresh, and filtered through multiple stages before reaching the taps. It's some of the best-tasting and safest water you'll find-please enjoy!

We appreciate your understanding and support in helping us conserve this precious resource.

HOT WATER SUPPLY

If you notice there's no hot water, please let us know right away. We might need to swap the gas bottles over, and we'll take care of it promptly to ensure you have hot water during your stay.

HOUSE SECURITY

Gates: Please keep the gates closed at all times.

Camera: There is a security camera & light on the NE corner of the house, facing down the driveway.

Smoke Alarm: The smoke alarm is located between the kitchen and the bedroom. The alarm is fitted with a tamper alert.

Fire Extinguisher: A fire extinguisher is located under the kitchen sink.

HEATING & COOLING

The reverse cycle air-conditioning keeps you warm in winter and cool in summer. Overhead fans in the living area and bedroom provide extra comfort on warmer days.

Please remember to turn off the air-conditioning and fans when leaving the apartment to help us conserve energy.

RUBBISH, WASTE & RECYCLING

We have an Aerobic Treatment Unit (ATU) system that requires special care, so please only flush toilet paper down the toilet. For everything else, use the bin provided in the bathroom.

Kitchen Waste Bins: There is a slide-out bin under the kitchen sink with separate compartments for general waste and recycling.

The large **outdoor bins** for general waste, recycling, and compost are located behind the water tank, on the left-hand side.

- General Waste (Red Bin): For all non-recyclable waste.
- Recycling (Yellow Bin): For paper, plastics, and wine bottles.
- Compost (Green Bin): For all food scraps, fruit, vegetables, and coffee grounds.
- Smaller Green Bins: Cans, plastic bottles, and glass bottles.

LAUNDRY

The laundry includes a washing machine, dryer, and all-natural laundry liquid. As this is a shared laundry space with us, your hosts, we keep the laundry locked. If and when you need to use it, just reach out to us, and we'll happily make it available.

During the summer, we often face severe drought conditions. Last Summer, we actually ran out of water! To help conserve this precious resource, we can't provide laundry access for stays shorter than 3 nights. If laundry facilities are essential for your trip, we recommend considering alternative accommodation.

EXTRA SUPPLIES

Towels & Linens: We've provided bath towels, a blanket for your comfort, as well as beach towels for your outdoor adventures. You'll also find a clothesline, pegs, an iron, and an ironing board in your wardrobe.

Toiletries: We provide a range of all-natural, non-toxic bathroom products from Koala Eco, including Hand Wash, Body Lotion, Body Wash & Shampoo & Conditioner. You'll also find a hairdryer and extra toilet rolls in the bathroom cupboard.

If you run out of anything or need your towels changed during your stay, just reach out and we'll be happy to assist.

MID-STAY CLEANING

If you're staying for 6 nights or more, please let us know if you'd like us to refresh the apartment with a mid-stay cleaning, change of bedding, and replenishment of essentials. We're happy to arrange this for your comfort!

BBQ & OUTDOOR DINING

BBQ: A Mini Weber BBQ is on your deck, ready to use. Simply open the cupboard and turn the valve to switch on the gas. Afterward, please turn off the gas and give the BBQ a quick clean with the provided wipes and scraper. If the gas runs out, let us know, and we'll replace it promptly.

Outdoor Dining: The deck has a wine barrel table and bar stools for alfresco dining. There's a citronella oil burner to keep bugs away. A lighter is in the kitchen to light it, but please ensure it's extinguished when you're done.

FIREPIT

Feel free to use the firepit during the cooler months (generally May to October). You'll find firewood, kindling, and firelighters in the bucket next to it. When finished, make sure the fire is fully out by pouring water over it. Please note, we follow Augusta Margaret River Shire guidelines, so firepit use may change without notice based on local fire restrictions.

LIGHTING

We've added various lighting options to create a comfortable and welcoming atmosphere:

- Fairy Lights: Strung over the deck for a magical touch. Use the button on the outside wall, halfway up, to turn them on or off.
- Security Light: A motion-sensor light near the North-East corner helps with visibility when coming and going at night.
- Arriving After Dark: We'll turn on the outdoor lights to guide you if you arrive after sunset.

General Tips:

- Please turn off all lights, including the fairy lights, before bed to conserve energy.
- If any lights aren't working, let us know and we'll replace the bulbs promptly.

ENTERTAINMENT

Television: The 43" Smart TV is connected to Netflix, Binge, Amazon Prime, and Disney+. You're welcome to use our Vineside accounts, or you can log in with your own credentials-just remember to log out on departure.

To watch live TV (Channel 7, 9, 10, etc.), navigate to the TV's home screen, select the channel, navigate to "Live TV."

If you have any trouble finding what you're looking for, feel free to reach out and we'll be happy to help! Enjoy your viewing experience.

ANIMALS ON THE PROPERTY

Our friendly dogs, Lily and Luna, may try to get your attention during your stay. We've recently installed a fence around Vineside, and it may take them some time to adjust. Since they can no longer run up to greet you, they may bark to get your attention. Don't worry, they're super friendly, and you can give them a pat through the fence. If you'd like, feel free to go through your back gate to interact with them-just please make sure they stay on their side of the gate and fence.

Please help us keep them safe by ensuring the gates are always closed. Also, don't let their puppy eyes fool you-Lily and Luna aren't allowed any food other than what we give them. Be aware that Luna is a bit of a thief and might snatch your shoes, socks, or anything else you leave unattended.

We're also excited to welcome free-range chickens soon, so it's even more important to keep the gates shut to prevent any feathered escapees!

WILDLIFE AWARENESS

We regularly have wild rabbits, the occasional fox (if you're lucky enough to spot one!), and plenty of bugs and flying insects around the property. To help manage the bugs, please turn off outside lights when you go to bed and keep the flywire on the windows and doors shut. If needed, there is a can of insect spray under the kitchen sink.

Snakes are common in this area, especially during the warmer months (generally from September to April). However, it is highly unlikely that you will see a snake and even less likely to be bitten by one. They are usually shy and prefer to avoid humans. If you do happen to see a snake, please stay calm and report it to us immediately.

In the extremely rare event that you are bitten by a snake:

- Stay as still as possible Movement can increase the spread of venom through the bloodstream.
- Do not panic and do not run Remaining calm can help slow your heart rate, minimising the spread of venom.
- Lie down and keep the affected limb immobilised
- Call for help immediately: dial 000 or have someone else call for help.
- Apply a pressure immobilisation bandage If you have a bandage or can make one from available materials, wrap the area firmly, starting just above the bite and continuing upwards along the limb. The bandage should be snug, but not so tight as to cut off circulation.

Stay vigilant by:

- Keeping a watchful eye on the ground where you're walking.
- Sticking to cleared pathways.
- Keeping doors closed to prevent any unwanted visitors.

GETTING HERE

- 1. Drive to Witchcliffe.
- 2. Turn onto Redgate Road near the petrol station.
- 3. Take the first left onto Eldridge Avenue.
- 4. Take the first left again onto McDermott Parade.
- 5. Follow McDermott Parade, passing houses and speed bumps, until you see a nature reserve on the left.
- 6. Look for the narrow driveway on the left, the number 57 and 'Vineside' is visible on the metre box. Open the gate and follow the driveway.
- 7. Park on the white stones in front of the "Parking" sign.

The entrance to the apartment is via the deck, next to your parking spot, marked by the "Vineside" sign. The door will be unlocked, and the keys will be in the door. If you would like help upon arrival, just let us know in advance!

THE BREWHOUSE

Located on the edge of town,
Brewhouse is a local favourite.
Backing onto the bush, it offers
the perfect blend of laid-back
vibes, great beer, and food. Their
"In the Pines" Pale Ale is a musttry, and they host live music
Fridays and Sundays.

CBCO BREWING

CBCo is all about uncomplicated, crowd-pleasing brews. Their Goldy Lager is a hit, and you can pair it with a game of golf on their Short Iron Range. Their laidback venue is perfect for an afternoon with friends.

BOOTLEG BREWERY

One of the oldest breweries in the region, Bootleg offers hearty pubstyle meals and adventurous craft beers. Their Raging Bull Dark Ale is legendary, and the lakeside setting with live music makes it a perfect place to relax.

CHEEKY MONKEY BREWING

Known for their cheeky brews,
Cheeky Monkey offers great beer and
scenic lakeside views. Their
Brewpub provides a rustic ambiance
perfect for enjoying adventurous
beers like their Cheeky IPA or
refreshing Pale Ale.

COWARAMUP BREWING CO

Set in a picturesque rural setting,
Cowaramup focuses on traditional
European-style ales and lagers.
Their German Pilsener and Porter
are local favourites. The brewery
features a large beer garden
perfect for lazy afternoons and
lawn games.

BEERFARM

Beerfarm was once a dairy farm, now a brewery known for its playful atmosphere and sustainable practices. Their IPL won Beer of the Year at the WA Good Food Guide Awards. Pair their paddock-to-plate meals with bold IPAs or their famous Milk Stout.

BEST DISTILLERIES



MARGARET RIVER DISTILLING CO.

Specialising in gin and whisky, this distillery is renowned for crafting artisanal spirits using local botanicals. Their cosy tasting room offers the perfect spot to sample their high-quality range, including limited-edition releases. Try the Giniversity Botanical Gin, a local favourite, or explore one of their unique seasonal creations.

THE GROVE DISTILLERY


